

From the Desk of Fr. Doug

Kathy Gibson

I ordinarily would not do this but if you knew Kathy Gibson, you'd understand why. Former first grade teacher at St. Patrick & West Park Catholic Academy, Kathy Gibson, is in need of help & prayers.

After West Park Catholic Academy closed, Kathy moved to Texas with her husband, Scott, for a teaching position. Every year they come back to Cleveland to visit family. Since birth she has been dealing with a bone disease that made it impossible for the doctors to operate. This crippling disease makes her bones more brittle than most people's. Even with this debilitating condition, Kathy would faithfully get to her first grade classroom on her crutches and put in a full day. The children loved her.

This July, Kathy had an accident and shattered her femur. She was in a nursing home for 60 days for rehabilitation. Then her insurance ran out. She is now at her sister's. She is applying for disability insurance but waiting for that to come through. Since she is no longer teaching she does not have insurance. She will be in Cleveland for at least another two months recuperating.

Meanwhile her husband is in Texas with an infection in his foot and cannot work. Scott also has multiple health related issues. Kathy has never asked for help before, but she's very courageous now and asking. If you can help in any way it is appreciated. If you cannot, please keep her and her family in your prayers.

Joyce Needham, former principal of WPCA and friend of many in the neighbor-

hood, is the person who told me about this. She wrote: "Doug, here is some background info for you if you get questions about Kathy. She reluctantly set up a Go-Fund-Me account. Could people donate cash or checks directly to Kathy without using Go-Fund-Me? Yes, that's what I did! Her sister's address is 4340 Thornridge Dr. Cleveland Ohio 44135. Or if you just want to call her to say hello and cheer her up, her cell number is 216-544-6674.

The list of people with needs is long. Everyone has a story. We help so many people without consideration of race, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender or nationality. I think I'm partial to this one because my mom was a first grade teacher in a Catholic school for 20 years. It's nice to be able to help someone who gave so much to the church by taking a lower salary for all those years. But the gift of money is not as important as your prayers. Please pray for her continued healing. And if you know Kathy, a call would be great. Thank you.

Sometimes your presence is all that's needed. That was the point of a story James Menkhous told during his talk at the Don Cozzens Memorial Lecture Series on September 13. A friend called because his father was dying and asked if Menkhous could come to the house. Even though he was out of state at the time, Menkhous agreed and drove all night to get there. They sat together by the dying man's bed, saying little. But conversation wasn't necessary. Just his presence in a time of need was enough to help the family through the ordeal. That's a tenet of Stephen Ministry: Just be present.
