#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**





### From the Desk of Fr. Doug

### November News

At our staff meeting on Tuesday we all agreed how fast the time has flown by. The last half of November is upon us and preparations must be made to make it happen.

Our new electronic sign outside is working just fine. Linda and Ginger and I continue to look at the many ways it can be used. As yet, we have not figured out how to upload pictures or videos but it can be done. Being able to publicize last week's craft fair and this Sunday's community meal are a great help in making the neighborhood aware of how they can benefit from the parish.

Retraining for Eucharistic ministers is this Tuesday, Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm. On Nov. 20, the feast of Christ the King, we will begin distributing communion under the form of bread and wine. All are encouraged to receive communion under both species as this is a fuller expression of the sacred meal we gather to celebrate. Consult last week's bulletin about the hygienic safety of receiving communion from the cup.

Our interfaith Thanksgiving service will be held live this year, our first interfaith get together since the pandemic. It will be held at the United Church of Christ on Rocky River Dr. just south of Lorain Ave. This will be an interfaith and intercultural event. There will be a combined choir. Prayer and biblical readings will be proclaimed in Hebrew and Arabic as well as English and Spanish. Translations will be displayed on video screens. There will be good eats afterwards provided by the Turkish American Cultural Center and Islamic Society. Internationally acclaimed Rev. Kito March, currently the pastor of Second Calvary Church on Bellaire Rd. will be the preacher.

November 27 is the first Sunday of Advent. Because Christmas also falls on a Sunday, we will be able to celebrate the full four weeks of Advent. Families or individuals will be asked to light the Advent wreath during our gathering hymn, Love's Pure Light. There are different verses for each week of Advent.

As we have done in past years, each week of Advent we will focus our attention on the needs of those outside the parish, especially women and children.

The first week we will be accepting gift cards for Zechariah House. Zechariah House was formerly known as Maggie's Place. Zechariah's House provides life-changing programs and services for pregnant and parenting women and their children, offering a warm and welcoming community, a safe place to live and learn and ongoing services to help them become self-sufficient.

The second week of Advent is always reserved for the Retirement Fund for Women Religious.

The third week of Advent we will accept gift cards for Haven House. Haven House accepts women and children who need to find shelter when all the regular women's shelters are full.

The final week we will once again have a collection for the St. Vincent de Paul Society which serves the needs of the larger community within our neighborhood.

December 8<sup>th</sup> is the feast of the Immaculate Conception, the patronal feast of our country. The vigil Mass will be on Wed Dec 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm instead of 4:00pm because of mobile pantry. Mass on Thursday Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> will be at 12:05pm.

After all that ministry, it will be time for fun and rejoicing. Returning for the first time since the pandemic is the holiday concert on Dec 9 at 7:00pm. Secular and sacred musical selections will resound with joy in our church. The concert is free and open to the public. The bell choir, adult choir and a quartet from Cleveland Institute of Music will perform. A free will offering will be taken up. Don't miss it.

#### **Caring Corner**


