OUR MISSION STATEMENT



.From Dee Ialacci's kitchen table to the people of Blessed Trinity

In the beginning, before Blessed Trinity was a gleam in our Father's eye, I was a St. Patrick parishioner. I was a teacher in the parish school and active in a number of parish ministries. Among the ministries were RCIA, Parish Council, Eucharistic Minister and Lector. Then along came the Clustering Committee. For over two years we met to answer the bishop's call. What will the church look like in West Park? Who would close? What ministries might merge? The answer was Blessed Trinity.

A new beginning - what would that mean? So with an open mind and heart I came, a different building with some new people and new opportunities.

I believed that we were called to ministry and it wasn't long before I heard His call. Can you lector? Be a Eucharistic Minister? Count the Sunday collection? Greet at fish fries? Make buckeyes for the craft fair? Be a part of women's ministry? Be a part of the hospitality committee? Welcome the bereaved as part of the bereavement ministry? Of course I said "yes" to all of them.

In just a few months, Blessed Trinity will be celebrating thirteen fruitful years, figuratively and literally. When I began this adventure I was in my late 60s. Now I'm in my early 80s. With age came a little more arthritis and a little less energy. Is it time for me to move on or time for me to move a little slower? I'm opting for slower!

The joy of ministry is to be shared. So I'm asking "Are you ready to say 'yes' when the opportunity presents itself?" As St. Francis says, "It is in giving that we receive." Think about it.

Thank you, Dee, and for the many other disciples like you, who have stepped up to make our parish an active, vibrant place where the mission of Jesus Christ thrives.

In addition to traditional parish groups and liturgical ministries, over the past 13 years we have started adopt-a spot, A.W.E., a community meal, What's on Your Mind, the community garden, Edible Forests I and II, the Apiary, mobile pantry, the microloan program, Stephen Ministry, an LGBTQ support group, witness in solidarity for Ukraine, and most recently, the ID Crisis Collaborative.

Parishioners have also stepped up to share their gifts and talents. We have had parishioners lead our Lenten series, preach, speak at adult education opportunities, and give workshops. Our latest workshop will begin March 19 between the 9 and 11 am Masses, focusing on how to keep nursing homes from getting all your money; wealth management and things to plan for your financial future. This workshop is organized and led by new parishioner, Monica Woodman and her team of experts.

We are blessed to have so many parishioners who understand that their baptismal call entitles them to do ministry. Are there other ministries we may need? Yes. Many have commented on the number of new, young families with small children. Perhaps it is time to resurrect vacation bible study in the summer. Perhaps these young families want to gather to address issues of faith development for their children or for themselves as parents. Dee Ialacci heard the call and said "yes". Come share the fun. Say "yes", to a new or tried and true ministry at Blessed Trinity parish.
