

Gratitude for a Wondrous Holy Week

Our Holy Week services were moving this year. We are so grateful to all those we could see serving in the ministry of worship. Altar servers, lectors, cantors, choir, bell choir, homilists, ushers, greeters and lift operators made everything run so smoothly.

I mentioned at the end of the Easter vigil, all the people behind the scenes that made it possible. Anne and Steve Suding are two of those people who not only served as sacristans but did so many other things. They trained the servers for Palm Sunday and Holy Saturday and came to rehearsals for those services. They set up chairs for Holy Saturday, got the towels ready and took the dirty laundry home afterwards to wash it.

They helped put those little papers on the congregational candles, arranged the microphones and text for the Easter vigil, made sure all the necessary extras like the stylus, the flashlight, the follower and the holy water fonts were cleaned. Steve did the lights during the liturgy of the word at the Easter vigil and Anne also was cantor for one of the psalms. Those three days would not have happened without them.


Also Phil our custodian gets special mention. Phil hates heights but he put up and took down the purple banners. He set up the sound system for Palm Sunday and brought the needed tables over. He brought them back for the vigil and did the same thing. Phil cleaned out the baptismal font after the Holy Thursday service and did the same on the Monday after Easter. With the help of Chris Malinowski, Phil and Chris gathered braches from all over the property to build the Easter fire. They wetted the ground around the fire for safety purposes, had a hose ready just in case and cleaned up everything by Monday morning. They took the bulletins over and cleaned up the pews on Monday as well.

Thanks to the bread bakers who let us "taste and see the goodness of the Lord"; to Frank Budziak, our office manager, who got schedules ready and bulletins sent out on time; to Katie for printing certificates and preparing the children for all three sacraments of initiation; to the parents of Eloise, Flannery and Ella for helping them prepare for that big day; to the spouses of those who memorized readings for Holy Saturday, who shared their anxiety daily in the weeks leading up to the vigil; and to my infectious disease specialist who enabled me to be here for another year.

Thanks also to Ginger who ordered out palms months before and also our Paschal candle. We got a discount for ordering it in October of last year.

Someone had to go buy Easter flowers and arrange them on the altar. Someone is watering them to keep them alive. Someone cleaned up the church of forgotten items and left over papers.

All of these hidden hands made our liturgies relevant, prayerful and meaningful. Thank you to all those, visible and invisible, who made Holy Week a time of great celebration.


