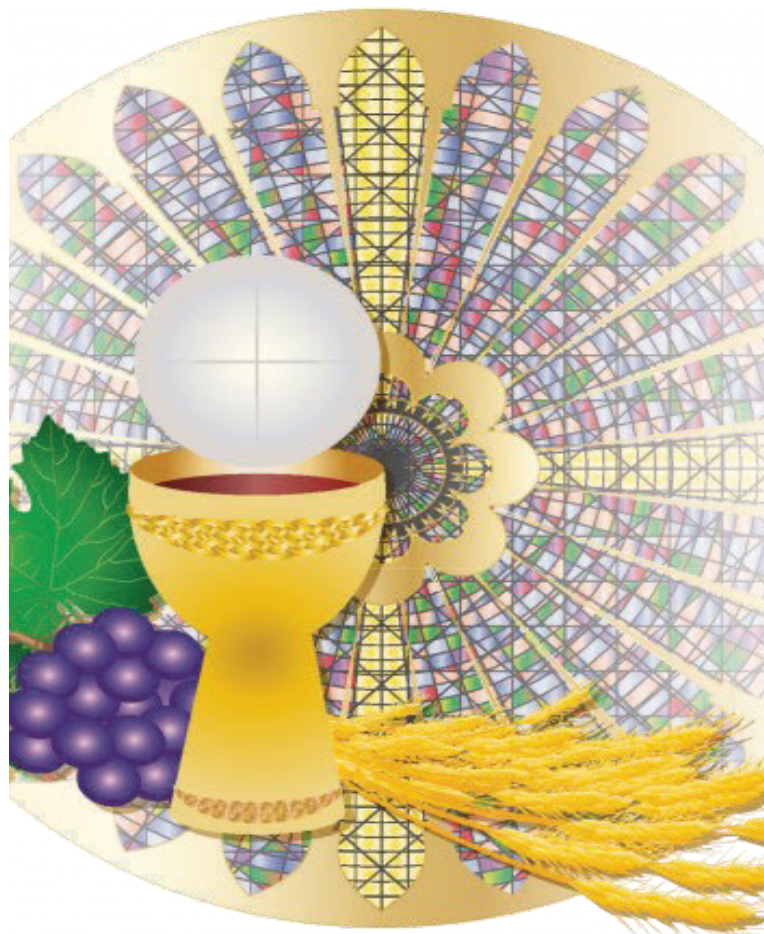

From the Desk of Fr. Doug

We and The Lord (Eucharistic Revival part 6)

The Mass is the prayer of the church addressed to God, our Father. That's news.

"The Lord be with you." How difficult is that to understand. You might be surprised that it doesn't mean what you think it means. The word, "Lord" is used many times throughout the liturgy. Sometimes it refers to the God, the Family of God, the Trinity, as it also did during last Sunday's first reading from Exodus. Sometimes it refers just to Jesus Christ as in the Lord's Supper. How can you tell what is meant?

Usually when "The Lord" is used by itself, it means God. So when the priest says The Lord be with you, he means God be with you, not Jesus. (That's also the origin of the word, "goodbye", but don't leave when the priest says that!)

Here are the moments during Mass when "Lord" refers to the Trinity:

Anytime we say, "The Lord be with you".

During the Glory to God when we say "Lord God, heavenly King, Almighty God and Father".

After the readings: "The Word of the Lord".

As a response: "Lord, hear our prayer."

During the Preface Dialogue –

"The Lord be with you..."

"We lift them up to the Lord..."

"Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God."

In the Holy, Holy: "Holy, holy, holy Lord"

At the beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer

"You are indeed holy, O Lord..."

After the Our Father: "Deliver us, Lord, from every evil..."

At the dismissal: "Let us go in peace, glorifying the Lord by our lives."

Here are the moments during Mass when "Lord" refers to Jesus Christ

The penitential rite: "Lord, Have mercy"

During the Glory to God: "Lord, Jesus Christ, Lord God, Lamb of God...and also you alone are the Lord".

After the Gospel "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ".

In the preface: "through Jesus Christ our Lord."

In the Eucharistic Prayer,.. "that they (the bread and wine) may become the body and blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ."

"Remember, Lord, your church, spread..."

"through Christ our Lord, from whom all good things come."

At Communion: "Lord, I am not worthy..."

It's ambiguous and confusing for sure.

The Eucharistic Prayer involves the whole assembly, not just the priest. It begins with the preface dialogue and ends with the great Amen. Look at how often the third person is used in third Eucharistic prayer.

"And so father, *we* bring you these gifts..."

"*We* humbly implore you to make..."

"That *we* have brought to you..."

"At whose command *we* celebrate these..."

"Therefore, as *we* celebrate the memorial

"*We* offer you in thanksgiving this holy and living sacrifice..."

"Look, *we* pray, on the oblation of your church..."

"The victim that has reconciled *us*..."

"Grant that *we* who are nourished by..."

"May he make *us* an everlasting gift to you..."

"And enable *us*..."

"That *we* may obtain an inheritance with....

"Have mercy on us *we* pray..."

"*We* hope to enjoy forever, the vision..."

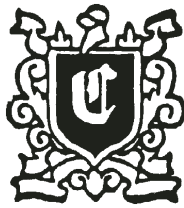

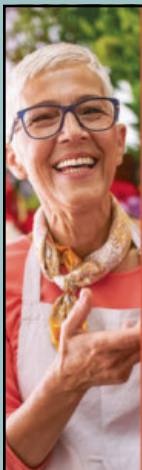

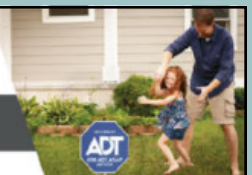
