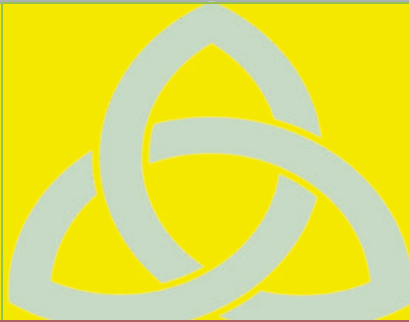

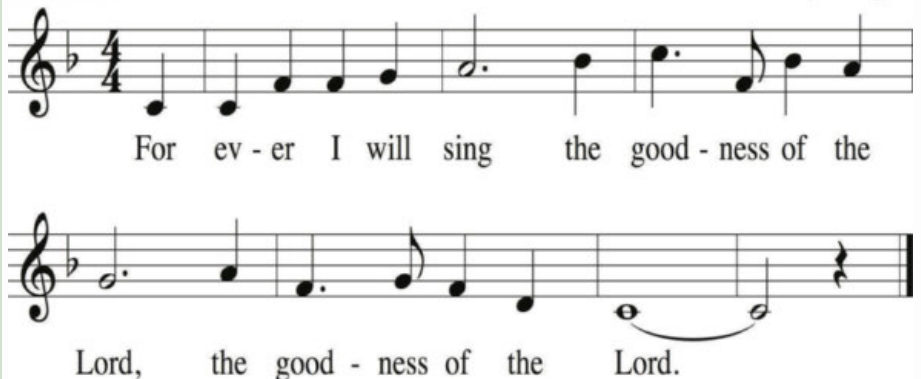

From the Desk of Fr. Doug Immigration News

What you do for the least of my brothers and sisters, you do for me. (Mt 25:40)

Did you know that 98% of people who seek asylum in the United States have a U sponsor such as a family member or friend ready to accept and support them? Did you know that many asylum seekers are professionals, such as pharmacists, engineers and chefs? Did you know there is an orphanage in Eagle Pass, Texas that cares for children whose parents have died along the way?

In 2016, the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary, through a congregational corporate stand, publicly committed working on behalf of immigrants and refugees. The congregation is dedicated to providing resources to resist racism, advocating for human rights and creating welcoming communities by partnering with organizations helping immigrants and refugees.

Laredo, Texas, is a dangerous border crossing because the drug cartels position themselves there to extort migrants, refugee and asylum seekers. They legally buy guns in the US and then take them across the border. Families who do make it across are processed 10 at a time. It takes about three hours.

The refugee fund of the SNJM community provides grants to organizations where a sister or associate is involved in service or organizing. Examples of how those grants have been used include: providing food, clothing and shelter to im-

migrants, providing training to help refugees cope with the trauma they experienced in their home country, and providing legal support to help asylum seekers navigate the US immigration process and paperwork.

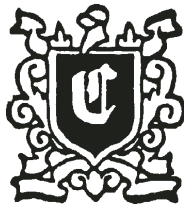

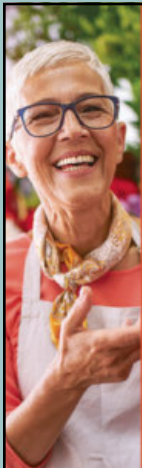
