Missionary Appeal

Next weekend, Fr. Michael Carson will be here for our annual mission appeal. This year's appeal is for the diocese of Gallup, New Mexico. The information I'm providing below will give you an idea of why another diocese in the USA is asking us for some support.

Father Carson is the assistant director of Native American Affairs at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington, D.C. He serves as the staff person to the USCCB Subcommittee on Native American Affairs. Father Carson, a priest of the Diocese of San Jose, California, worked extensively in the Navajo Nation at Christ the King Parish in Shiprock, in the northern part of New Mexico.

The diocese of Gallup has 36 priests, 27 permanent deacons, 67 religious sisters and 6 religious brothers. These people serve 52 parishes and 22 mission churches. The diocese of Gallup covers 55,468 square miles, an area about the same size as the entire state of Illinois. It includes an area of Northeast Arizona.

The Catholic population is just over 107,000 out of just over 401,000.

The Gallup diocese averages about 9" of rain per year.

There are Catholics from seven Native American tribes: Navajo, Zuni, Acoma, Laguna, Hopi, Jicarilla Apache and White Mountain Apache. In order to better meet the needs of the people of these cultures, in 2012 Bishop James Wall established the Office of Native American Ministry, headed by Fr. Dale Jamison. The purpose of this office is to assess and meet the spiritual needs of the Native American members of the Diocese.

The Office of Life, Peace, Justice and Creation Stewardship collaborates with local, state and national organizations and churches to be aware of key issues and respond appropriately. This office actively participates in education conferences on Welfare to Work, Domestic Violence, Predatory Lending, the Death Penalty, Prisons for Immigrants, World Debt, Disaster Relief, Ecological concerns, Uranium mining and water.

In chatting with Fr. Mike, he informed me that he is addicted to Starbucks. He asked if there was one nearby and I told him, "Yes" but it's just a little too far to walk. (He's flying in Saturday afternoon.) So if you want to arrange to take Fr. Mike out to dinner on Saturday evening, or give him a ride up to Starbucks on the corner of W.150 and Lorain, I'm sure he would be most appreciative.

I am starting my much anticipated and greatly needed vacation this Sunday after Masses are done. I'll be returning on Saturday, August 12. Zucchini are ripening and so are some of the fruit. I have asked Diane Kortan to keep an eye on it and if it is ready for picking to ask Katie to send out a flock note asking for harvesters. David Kamms has volunteered to keep the garden beds watered as well as the in ground vegetables. Our new secretary, Krystal Rodriguez will have had a week under her belt by now so she can attend to your needs.

Finally, save the date, Sunday September 17, from 1-5pm. It will be a special day with a classic car show, picnic food and beverages and more. Details are still being worked out.

Caring Corner



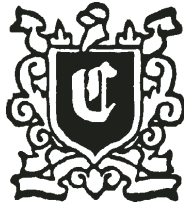

Others keep gratitude journals in which they write down three moments of joy or humor they experienced during that day for which they felt grateful.

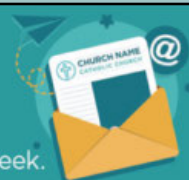
