

Pray for Our Stephen Ministers in Training

This Sunday, August 6, our Stephen Ministers will attend a continuing education session on The Gift of Empathy. Empathy is something we all need, and it's something we all can give.

Empathy is an essential skill for effective Stephen Ministers. It is defined as the ability to sense the feelings of another person — without forgetting that you are a separate person.

Empathy is an excellent approach to caring relationships. It enables a caregiver to feel another's pain while firmly hanging on to his or her reality and sense of self. By practicing empathy, a caregiver provides stable support for a care receiver, showing them they're not alone as they work through their problems and challenges.

Through this training, our Stephen Ministers will learn how to relate with empathy to their care receivers and, indeed, in all areas of their lives. There are some common aspects to all areas of empathy which our Ministers will learn. But each person empathizes in ways consistent with their personality.

So please hold our Stephen Ministers in prayer on Sunday afternoon as they work and pray together to hone their caregiving skills.

Our Stephen Ministers are well-trained lay caregivers, able to provide a high level of Christ -centered emotional and spiritual care to people experiencing a wide range of life difficulties. It's free, it's confidential, and it's a powerful way our church can minister to people who are hurting.

Situations in which individuals could benefit from the emotional and spiritual care of a Stephen Minister include grief after the death of a loved one or other losses in life, a major medical crisis, job-related crises, divorce or broken relationship, chronic care situation, long-term illnesses, end of life or hospice situation, major life transitions, and difficult family situations.

Besides supporting our Stephen Ministers in prayer, there's another way you can help them and the parish — acting as a lookout. Lookouts can play a crucial role in this ministry by helping identify people who are hurting and connecting them to our Stephen Ministry. While you look for potential care receivers, keep these points in

mind:

People all around you, in all areas of life, may be hurting and in need of care. It's just a matter of recognizing those needs when they arise.

Many hurting people are receptive to Stephen Ministry when it's offered to them.

People are unlikely to reach out and ask for help on their own — so lookouts need to actively seek out and talk with potential care receivers.

If you are aware of person you think might benefit from the care of a Stephen Minister, follow these four steps to paving the way for Stephen Ministry:

Express care and concern in a way that feels natural. For example, "I'm sorry to hear about what you're going through, and I want to let you know how much I care." Then listen if the person wants to share.

Tell the potential care receiver about Stephen Ministry. You can learn more about the ministry by visiting our web page on the parish internet site. You don't need to say a lot — the Referrals Coordinator will explain in more detail later in the process.

Get permission to pass along the person's name and phone number. This is important. Never refer someone without their permission. If the person says no or needs time to think about it, check back later in a caring way.

If the person agrees, pass the information along to our Referrals Coordinator by calling the rectory at 216-671-5890 Extension 19. Avoid promising a minister to the person. The Referrals Coordinator needs to consider a number of factors before deciding whether to assign a Stephen Minister.

Thank you for considering to serve in this crucial role. Your identifying potential care receivers and paving the way with them will help us meet many more needs for care in our congregation and community.
