Our next community meal is Sunday, Nov 12 from 12 noon -1pm. Come and share your personality with a fellow parishioner.

The fundraiser for Baraderes, Haiti is this Friday, Nov 17 at St. Mel Hall. It is handicap accessible. \$25 tickets include dinner and beverages. There will be side boards and Asian raffle baskets.

Our annual interfaith Thanksgiving service will be held at the United Church of Christ on Rocky River Drive near Kamms Corner on Tuesday evening, Nov 21 at 7:00pm. Attendees are asked to bring a can or box of food to be distributed to local hunger centers or to make a cash donation. The service is conducted in three languages with translations and there is a combined choir from all interested congregations.

Mass on Thanksgiving Day will be at 9:30am on November 23. It is a good way to give thanks to God for all the blessings that we have. Plus everyone who is there is there because they want to be.

This year, Christmas falls on a Monday. That means on Sunday morning, December 24 we will be celebrating the fourth Sunday of Advent and on Sunday afternoon at 4pm, we will be celebrating the Christmas Eve vigil mass. Sometime between 12 noon and 3pm on Dec 24, the Advent decorations will have to be taken down and the Christmas decorations will have to go up. Plan ahead to be able to help if even for only a half hour.

Our annual interfaith service for peace is held on New Year's Eve at 7:00pm here at Blessed Trinity. Past speakers include Frank ____ who spoke about what it is like to grow up as an African American. Rabbi Enid Leder who spoke on anti-semitism, Pastor Jason Thompson who spoke about homophobia and Alan Kolp, who spoke about the Quaker principle of non-violence. It is a worthwhile evening followed by refreshments. Then you can get home early or go out to bring in the New Year.

In addition to these wonderful opportunities to gather with others, the parish provides many ways you can grow in your faith.

There is bible study twice a month. This is done in person or via Zoom. It couldn't be more convenient than that.

There are a number of prayer groups in the parish of 6-10 people. Some of them are open to new members. If you are interested, let me know and I will connect you with one of them.

Centering prayer meets in the Joseph Center twice a month. All are welcome. Consult the bulletin for the week's activities and just show up to find out what it is about.

The Legion of Mary meets for prayer on Monday mornings in church and then joins me in celebrating the Eucharist at West Park Neurological Center for 11:00am Mass.

Men's ministry meet bi-monthly for faith and fellowship - and breakfast.

Women's ministry includes any number of ministries.

There is women's faith sharing on the 2nd Thursday of the month in the Joseph Center.

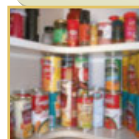

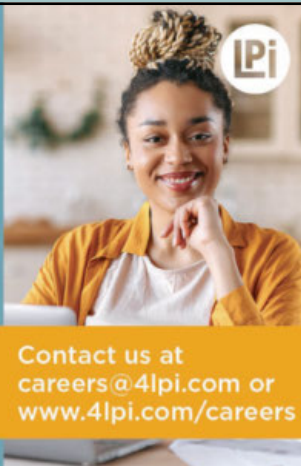
