




THE SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Advent inspirations

This year, the Second Sunday of Advent comes exactly in between two great feasts of Mary: the Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of Guadalupe. The feast of the Immaculate Conception celebrates Mary as the first one redeemed by Christ; we might think of her as the first fully human person in history, the one who fulfilled all her potential as a child of God, a fully self-giving collaborator with the plan of God. The feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe brings the Gospel message uniquely home to the Americas. In celebrating La Morenita (as she is fondly called in Spanish-speaking cultures and which means "the little brown skinned girl"), we celebrate the fact that the Incarnation implies enculturation. Just as the Word took flesh in the first century, Our Lady of Guadalupe is a visible image of Christianity's ability to express itself in the signs and symbols, the language and culture of every people on earth.

The Second Sunday of Advent invites us to a meta-dream. Isaiah and the images of the Blessed Virgin give us a vision of what life can be like. We are created with the potential to share divine life, to share the joy of being part of a humanity at peace, smoothing out what divides us and rejoicing in the multiple ways our different cultures can incarnate the love of God. We will never make it happen if we don't first imagine it. The call to repent is a call to let go of our puny expectations. The promise of forgiveness tells us that God will never condemn us to remain trapped in the selfishness we have chosen. There is always more possibility.

Finally, the promise of Christ's gift of the Holy Spirit tells us that we, like Mary, can be overshadowed by God and become bearers of Christ's presence in our world. The glory of the Lord can be revealed in us and among us. Let us open our minds and hearts and prepare the way of the Lord.

On New Year's Eve we will be having our annual Interfaith Peace Vigil at 7:00pm. In light of this year's conflict in Israel and Gaza I have invited Fatima Abuabsa and the board of Cleveland State Students for Justice in Palestine to come and share their insights about what the news tells us, what it's not telling us and what they think we should know.

Fatima writes in part, "I am the President of Cleveland State University's Students for Justice in Palestine, so would it be okay for my board to attend? I would like to be prepared as can be! We do have a Palestinian Christian friend and her name is Halla. I think sharing her experience as well would be a unique perspective because a lot of people believe that almost all Palestinians are Muslims". So before you go out the ring in the New Year, come and let us pray for peace together.

A couple of people have asked me when I stopped writing flock notes. You should be getting one every day unless I announce in advance that I will be away on vacation. If you stopped receiving them, call the rectory and leave me a message and we'll get you put back on the list so that you can receive these priceless gems.

How do you get bumped off of flock notes? A member's email address may not be verified. You will notice a checkmark next to each email in the member's profile indicating that their email is verified. If this checkmark is missing, this means their email is not verified and therefore cannot receive your notes until it is verified. You can verify a member's email for them by clicking on their member profile and clicking the 'verify email' button located underneath their email. Once their email is verified they will begin receiving your email notes.

A member may be opted out of receiving emails from that group. The member may have an email listed; however, they have turned off their email notifications for the group in their notification settings.

Finally, the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on a Sunday. Morning Masses will follow the usual schedule. The Christmas Eve vigil Mass will be at 4:00pm. This means that the Advent decorations will have to be taken down and the Christmas decorations and manger scene set up within a matter of hours. If you can stay after the 11:00am Mass to help, that would be great.
