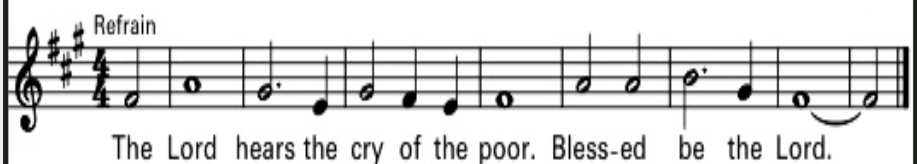
OUR MISSION STATEMENT

Parish Pictorial Directory

Have you ever wondered what that person's name is standing near you in church? You know they told you once but you are embarrassed to ask again? Have you ever heard that a parishioner passed away but you don't know who they are? Has your family had a professional portrait taken lately? Are you looking for a good picture of yourself to include with your obituary? With the invention of the cell phone with camera, picture studios are pretty much a thing of the past. Most have gone out of business.

Universal Church Directories is a family owned business that is keeping the tradition of a parish directory alive. From start to finish, Universal Directories ensures that we, our disciples and volunteers, and all of our parishioners are given the respect and attention we need.

Katie and I attended an introductory meeting. We found a time and a place to do the picture taking and learned about what we need on our end.

The picture taking will take place in the rectory beginning Tuesday, April 30 to May 3 from 2 – 8pm and Saturday, May 4 from 10am - 4pm. We need three or more disciples to take responsibility to create a design for our directory, assist with sign-ups online and after Masses, contact every parishioner and serve as hosts the actual days of picture taking. These three or four need not do all the work themselves. They can enlist the help of other disciples. There are several sample directories from which this team can get ideas. It is not necessary to reinvent the wheel.

There are options as to the size of the directory, various layouts and so forth. Contact-

ing every registered family in the parish is a source of outreach. It may help reactivate the inactive.

Every person/household who has their picture taken will receive a free 8 x 10 as well as a free copy of the parish pictorial directory. There will also be an opportunity to take additional individual and family pictures. They told me, "Our portrait consultants and photographers create a fun, relaxed environment for photography with absolutely No Pressure (emphasis theirs) placed upon the parishioners to purchase".

The directory comes with an app so you can see it on your phone. This enables us to update and add to the directory down the road. It also includes parish controls and passwords that keep outsiders from accessing the pictures.

Some families may have concerns about their children having their photos in a parish pictorial directory. We understand that. May we suggest that at least the parents come in for a photo shoot so that each family can be included in the directory?

There is also an opportunity to include pictures of people who are away for college, on vacation, or homebound. We will get your picture and put it on a hard drive that we can give to the company. They charge \$15 per picture, but the parish will pick up \$10 of that cost so it will only cost you \$5. Our three or four coordinators and their helpers will make that happen.

Our first organizational meeting is February 27 at 7:00pm in the rectory. Would you be willing to be on the team that makes this happen? If so, contact Katie or Doug. We could even have more than three or four people to be on the team. Many hands make light work.

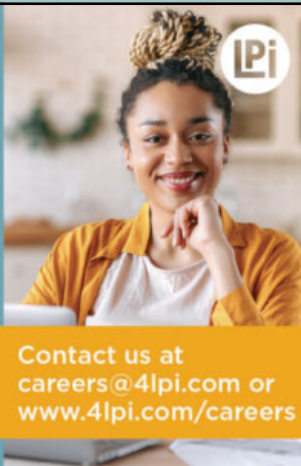
