

From Doug's desk...







Preparing for Holy Week

Holy Week begins next Sunday. It is the most solemn and most important week of the church's liturgical year. If at all possible, plan to attend the church's liturgies that week. We have cancelled or at least kept to a minimum other parish meetings that week so as to facilitate your participation in these beautiful days.

Holy week begins outside next Sunday, with the blessing of palms, weather permitting. We read the Gospel story of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem as the crowd laid their cloaks and palms branches in his path. Then we process into the church. The Passion according to St. Mark will be read. This day is also called Passion Sunday in addition to Palm Sunday, because the passion is always read. (On Good Friday we will hear the passion from John's Gospel.) The Holy Week liturgies are connected. To symbolically connect these liturgies, the Palm Sunday service ends in silence. There is no sending forth hymn. We processed into the church acclaiming Christ our King. We leave in silence praying that we will not be like the disciples who fled or the crowd that demanded the release of Barabbas instead of Jesus.

On Holy Thursday we remember the Last Supper. The Gospel reading for this day is the washing of the feet by Jesus. Eucharist is a call to service. It is an action verb. This is what John (and Jesus) wanted to communicate to his students.

This year on Good Friday there will be two services. The first will be the Stations of the Cross at noon. It will begin at St. Malachi Church and stop at various locations where the body of Christ is still being crucified today. People of faith from other religious communities will also be there, making this ecumenical service something that Jesus had in mind.

Our Catholic Good Friday Service will begin at 3:00pm. The service begins in silence. The priest and servers enter and lay prostrate in the sanctuary, a sign of submitting oneself to God's holy will. From there we have the opening prayer, the liturgy of the Word and the intercessions.

The veneration of the cross follows. One can venerate the cross by touching or kissing the cross beam, not the vertical beam. This allows two people to venerate the cross at the same time.

The communion rite follows. There is no Mass on Good Friday, just this service.

The highlight of the liturgical year is Holy Saturday's Easter vigil. This beautiful and moving service celebrates Christ's victory over sin and death and our return to new life. It is at this liturgy that Gary Williams will be baptized, confirmed and will receive his first Eucharist as a new Catholic and new parishioner.

The Easter vigil begins the service of light. We light the primeval fire. Then we light the Paschal candle, a symbol of Christ who dispels the darkness of night. Then we light our own congregational candles. The church is filled with the warmth and beauty of light. The "Exultet" is sung, Latin for let us sing.

The Liturgy of the Word follows. Seven readings and their response recall salvation history. A glorious Alleluia is sung for the first time since Ash Wednesday and the Gospel is proclaimed.

After the homily we celebrate the liturgy of baptism. Gary will walk in procession behind the Paschal candle, a symbol of his journey to the waters of new life. We will sing the litany of the saints during this procession, mindful of all those who have preceded us in faith and hope. Gary will then be baptized and confirmed.

The liturgy of the Eucharist follows. Once again "we remember, we celebrate and we believe" what God has done for us in Jesus Christ. We will join Gary in receiving Christ into our hands and hearts. We pray that we may become what we eat.

Mass concludes with the final blessing and the Easter Alleluia. We are sent forth, filled with hope in new life.
