

# **Entrepreneur Incubator at Blessed Trinity**

A Place Where Your Small Business Idea Can Grow

Do you have a small business that you are trying to grow, but need help and support to make it successful? The Entrepreneur Incubator at Blessed Trinity may be just what you are looking for.

The Entrepreneur Incubator team, based at Blessed Trinity Church on 140th Street and Puritas Road, is working to help grassroots entrepreneurs in the West Park area. For over three years, this team of parishioners and community members have been partnering with local entrepreneurs to help them grow and improve their small businesses.

They are excited to now expand the program to other participants looking to grow their business.

Applications are currently being accepted for this year-long program, which will start in April.

This program is designed especially for people who are in the early- to mid-stages of developing their business, but may not have prior business experience and are looking for help with next steps. It is open to anyone 18 years or older who lives or works in the West Park neighborhood of Cleveland. Participants are paired with a connector, who will work one-on-one with them throughout the year. During monthly meetings, participants are brought into a network of entrepreneurs and advisors who will provide training and advice in a range of areas, which may include legal, marketing, bookkeeping, financial, and business planning. The program also offers very low-interest business loans up to \$2000.

Applications must be received by April 30, 2024. Because only a limited number of participants can be accepted into the program, applications will be reviewed for certain criteria. It is important to have a solid business idea, some initial work put into the business, and a commitment to participate in the program.

Your business could be in manufacturing, service, or retail.
