What to Say?

One man, Michael Garvin was ordained to the priesthood for the diocese of Cleveland on May 19. In his homily, Bishop Malesic said the following. I wanted to add to some of the things he said.

"From today on, you will be called 'Father.' It will be strange at first."

Indeed it will. Most of the people you will minister to, will be old enough to be your father (and mother). But be mindful that the clericalism that runs rampant in our church was and is the cause of sexual abuse. That title "Father" gave the priest unquestioned authority and unearned respect. If "Father" said it was okay then it must be so. Doesn't the bible say "honor they father and thy mother?" So many young people did.

I remember going to a talk by a bishop once and he began it this way. "My name is Tom and I'll be your server today." Message received! There are some priests who forego the title "father" altogether, not only to weaken the clerical structures that infect our church, but simply to be true to the Gospel. "Call no one your father. You have but one father in heaven. (Mt 23:9)

Just as an aside, this would go a long way to foster ecumenical unity. Other Christian faiths use the word "pastor" to describe their parish leader.

"As a priest, Father Garvin – and all other priests – are configured to Christ in a special way", said the bishop.

So is everyone that has been baptized. 'Special' does not mean you're superior, privileged, unaccountable, holier, more powerful or any other kind of adjective that makes you entitled. And please do not be arrogant.

Bishop Malesic said he first met Father Garvin – who was a student at Saint Mary Seminary – in 2020, when he was appointed bishop of Cleveland. "Since then, I've come to know him as a gifted composer, musician and a techie." In fact, two musical pieces used in the ordination liturgy were among the newly ordained priest's work. He also created a computerized map of the diocese with lights that show which parishes are having Mass, confession or adoration at any given time.

Wow! what a gifted and talented man Michael is! His computerized map is something I could never even begin to assemble. Maybe he'd consider adding to that map. He could add places where there is a food pantry or the monthly fresh produce giveaway; maybe what parishes have AA meetings and on what days, which churches have a hot community meal, Stephen Ministry, bible study. It would be good to know where to go to get a bus pass, an ID, find a women's shelter, rent money, a men's shelter, and so on.

Now that he has been ordained, the bishop told Father Garvin to use his skills and priesthood "to help us come face to face, to encounter the living God. As Timothy said, be persistent, whether convenient or inconvenient. Celebrate the sacraments with dignity for us," he added.

I can't ever think of a time when I did not celebrate a sacrament with dignity, respect and attentiveness. But after that hour is over, if you asked me if I treated all the people I met that day with dignity, respect and attentiveness, the answer is "no". I fall far short. Leading the people in prayer and worship is easy. Dealing with people and relationships and building community is the hard part.

Let us pray for this newly ordained young man. May his learning curve be faster than mine was. And may he learn that the curve is still learning.
