



34 Psalm 34: Taste and See

When I came in from the garden, a woman had left a message. "Hello Fr. Doug. This is Jane Doe (not her real name) I'm not sure if you remember me but you baptized our daughter Rumpelstiltskin (not her real name) three years ago. (I thought to myself, 'No, I'm not Sheldon Cooper. I don't remember you.') We've had another baby and we'd like to get her baptized." After some thought, I called back, and since no one answered, I left this message.

"Congratulations on your new baby. We have recently updated our parish data base in preparation for the new Guidebook. Since we have not seen or heard from you in three years, we removed you from our parish membership. I'm sure you can find a new parish that will welcome you and baptize your child".

Baptism is not magic. It doesn't make you a good Christian. It won't guarantee that you go to heaven. Parish membership is more than a name in a data base. It is a commitment to the community, first through worship and praise and then through service.

Now I could have said I'd baptize your child after I make you attend a baptism class and I explain what baptism means. But I've learned over the years that people will jump through however many hoops you want them to jump through to get what they want.

I recall a woman who wanted to get married here. I said "You have to start coming to church on Sunday. So she did. Every Sunday. For six months. The day of the wedding was the last day I saw her. What's the point?

Two young ladies joined the parish last week on two separate occasions. This was not surprising since we have been attracting many young people and young families over the past few years. I had a nice "get acquainted" conversation with both of them. Then each one said they were asked to be a sponsor for a baptism. Getting a sponsor certificate "from the parish they belonged to" was just another hoop they had to jump through. Enduring a 'welcome to the parish' conversation with me was just another hoop. Now, the sponsor certificate they sign begins with "I affirm that I am a practicing Catholic, etc...." There is a place for them to sign the certificate and a place for me to sign it. I just attest to the fact that they are registered in the parish at the moment. Signing the certificate is on their conscience.

Contrast this with Steve and Alexandra or JD and Olivia, both of whom were married earlier this year. Even before they were married, Oliva and Alex both signed up for the bread baking ministry. They made new friends. They had a sense of belonging. Both couples attend Mass every week. They pray with us. They are part of the community. They belong.

There are some members who never participate in anything the parish does. They never buy raffle tickets or gifts cards, attend a prayer group, learn the person's name next to them, pick up a hymnal, etc. We describe them as disengaged. I don't know why they come? I suspect they think Mass attendance and Catholicism are the same and that they will get to heaven this way. Sorry. It's not. Belonging is not magic. It's a commitment.

I had many friends and catechists in El Salvador who were martyred by the army for their faith. If you participated in church life, you were considered suspect. It was a sin to be young. I'll never forget the day the army came and blew the brains out of our parish sacristan, Armando and his friend, Carlos. He gave his life for the Gospel. I can't let someone cheapen his death because they want to get their baby baptized. (I visit his grave every time I go back to El Salvador)

I was in El Salvador less than 24 hours. At my first Mass in a country village, a jeep arrived in the middle of Mass and six soldiers with machine guns surrounded us. Twelve priests and Oscar Romero had already been murdered, martyred. Nothing happened during Mass. After Mass the army told the people that I was a communist and stay away from church and the padre. Later that year, the catechist disappeared, his body never discovered.

Being a true disciple is serious business. It's not about getting what you want. It's about giving what you can. It's about lifting up the body of Christ in the field hospital.
