

# Psalm 30: I Will Praise You, Lord 30





A couple months ago I had pretty much given up on finding a new, full time music minister. I had advertised the position on the diocesan website, at the Cleveland Institute of Music (that's where we got Sonia), Baldwin Wallace, Oberlin College, The Music Settlement and the National Pastoral Musician's Association website. No applications. At that point I left it in God's hands. "Please send us someone." I should have done that earlier.

Then a young man emailed wondering if we had a need for someone to play music on Saturdays. I answered his email right away and asked him to come in for an interview. He told me that he is going to be a senior at Cleveland State University, majoring in vocal music performance. So I knew he could sing, but could he play the piano? When I asked him he said, "I started playing when I was seven". He came in for an audition, played beautifully and I hired him on the spot for every Saturday.

Although he was playing at Lakewood Baptist church on Sundays, he was looking to make more money to pay for school. Baptists have no services on Saturday and one service on Sundays. We have two. One thing led to another and before you know it, he had a weekend job offer. After thinking about it for a few days, he accepted our offer.

Julio Santana is our new music minister. He starts full time this weekend. He has sung as a chorister and cantor at St. John Cathedral on E 9th St.

Julio lives in nearby Lakewood. He is one of five siblings. He tells me his parents "are not musical", but all five of the children are. An older brother recently conducted a concert at Carnegie Hall. Another one 'does kind of poetry/rapper stuff. The other two play instruments.

Like the rest of us, Julio tries to work out more, but doesn't always succeed. He likes to dance, especially some of the native dances from his Puerto Rican/Honduran nationality background.

Julio attended Northern Ohio Adventist Academy (Sheffield Lake, OH) for 9th-10th grades; Indiana Academy (Cicero, IN) for 11th-12th grades; Andrews University (Berrien Springs, MI): 1st-2nd year; Cleveland State University: 3rd (2022-2024)

This fall he'll be a 4th year in credits (his fifth year in undergrad). Julio hopes to continue his studies with a graduate degree but assured me that he really is enjoying his new position and will continue on, long after he graduates from CSU. (Thank you, Jesus!)

Julio has been in a bell choir and has sung in choirs and choruses. In the fall he will make an attempt to direct the bell choir and the adult choir. Right now he is becoming familiar with the order of worship of the Catholic Mass. He is unfamiliar with our hymns and is learning how to play new hymns and psalms every week. And he is doing a great job. I love the way he plays the Our Father from the Mass of St. Catherine Drexel. I hope that when we start repeating hymns, his work load will be easier. At least Christmas season will be easier. Most of the hymns will be familiar.
