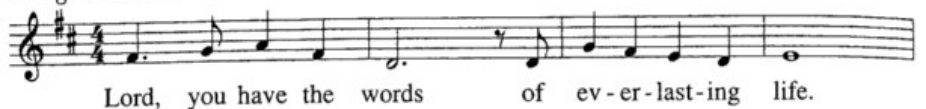
### OUR MISSION STATEMENT

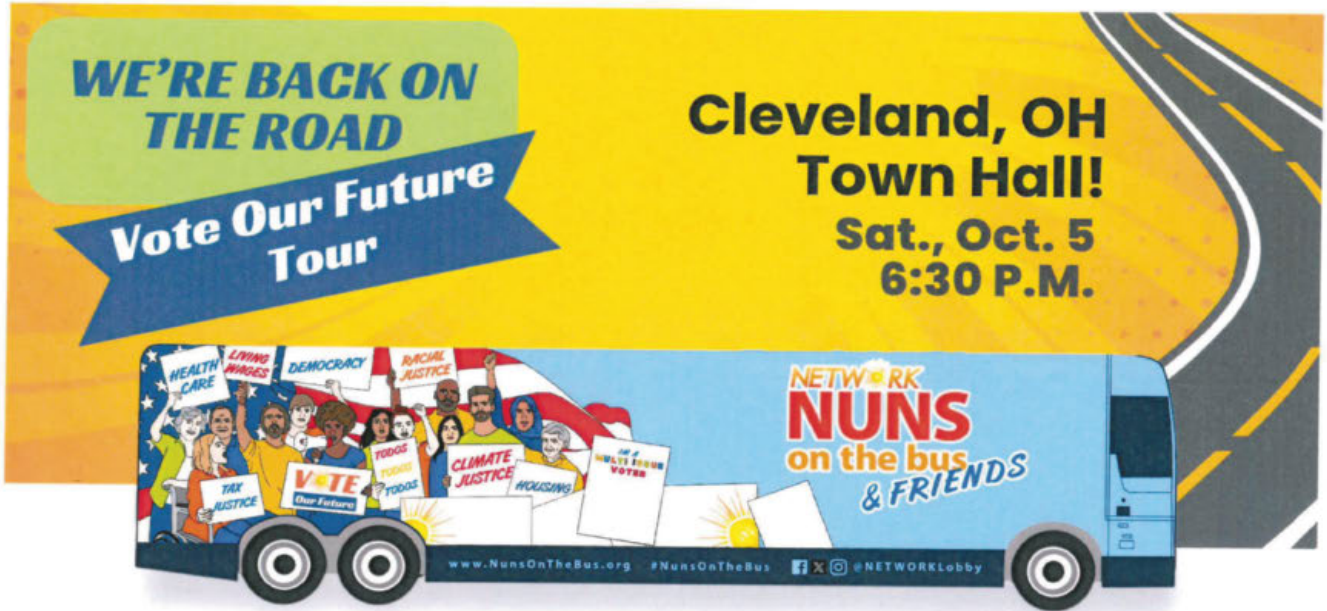
