FROM THE DESK OF FR DOUG...

I am pleased to announce that Briyant Hines will be joining our parish pastoral staff beginning November 1 as a pastoral associate. I have asked Briyant to introduce himself to the parish by writing my "From the desk of Fr. Doug" column.

Who am I– Briyant Hines

Who am I? That in itself is a loaded question. While some will say they do not know, others will tell you they are ever evolving and still figuring it out. I am a part of the latter. However, I can give you a snippet of who I am today by laying a very telling foundation through the basics and core values I possess.

It is important for the people I serve through Blessed Trinity to know that I am originally from Cleveland, Ohio. I grew up on the east side of Cleveland my entire life. I have two brothers and a sister with a host of nieces and nephews whom I dote on at any given chance. My mother works in the medical field. Speaking of Atlanta, before I came back to Cleveland, I spent the last 14 years there. While in Atlanta, I excelled academically through undergrad, graduate, and postgraduate studies. I graduated with my Master of Divinity from Candler School of Theology at Emory University. From there, I earned four units of Clinical Pastoral Education with a focus on mental and spiritual health. It was during these units as an intern and resident that I sharpened my skills in pastoral care and crisis management and intervention. While working on my CPE units, I taught Religious Studies courses at Beulah Heights University in Atlanta, Georgia. Currently, I am in a doctorate program focusing on Spiritual Renewal. One of my main goals in that program is designing a curriculum for discipleship enrichment in the 21st century.

Now that we have covered the basics, it's time I reveal who I truly am and why I am here at Blessed Trinity. You learn a lot about a person by learning what their core values are.

My core values are authenticity, compassion, justice, and accountability, just to name a few. Those top four core values are the pillars of who I am from a spiritual and natural perspective. It is my belief that one cannot do the will of God and serve others without those four components. God requires me to be authentic, to show my scars so that I may be able to build or be a part of a genuine spiritual community. In my authenticity, there must be compassion. Because I struggle, because I have scars, because I am far from perfect, I am much better able to empathize and have compassion for others who are struggling and caught up in spiritual crosswire. Justice is a value that I will never compromise on. God calls me to bring justice where there is injustice, to fight for those who are being oppressed in any way, shape, or form. I am not called to sit idly by. Accountability is birthed from the previous core values. I must be accountable for not only my actions, but the actions that I see around me. I must be accountable for seeing a need and not waiting for someone else to take action, but take action myself.

My core values are why I am here at Blessed Trinity. While on this search, I petitioned God to send me where I am needed the most. It is apparent that my appointment as pastoral assistant is ordained by God because it is the Spirit that led me here.

I cannot wait to see the work that God will do through me as well as the parishioners at Blessed Trinity. I could only hope to make a fraction of the impact that my predecessor has made.

I look forward to serving and laboring in the faith with you all.
