



Come to Our Library

Some of you may be unaware or have forgotten that there is a library of religious books in the rectory. You are welcome to come and sign out a book or read it here. The library contains a wide variety of topics including church documents, social justice issues, lives of the saints, spirituality and more.

Recently Laura Kuhn dropped off the following books. Five are about Jesus and five are by Pope Francis.

Jesus Before Christianity 25th Anniversary edition by the Rev. Albert Nolan, O.P. Nolan's portrait of Jesus introduces us to the man as he was before he became enshrined in doctrine, dogma and ritual, a man deeply involved with the real problems of his time – which are the real problems of our time as well.

The Jesus Meditations, A Guide for Contemplation by Michael Kennedy. These meditations put you on the dusty roads of Palestine, in the crowds, etc.

Experiencing Jesus, also by Michael Kennedy. In our world today, in the midst of war, poverty, and social turmoil there has never been a greater need for Christians to return to Jesus in prayer. The meditations also come with a CD.

A Mystical Portrait of Jesus by Demetrius Dumm. Using a new and daring approach, Fr. Dumm brings remarkably fresh insights to John's Gospel.

The Cultural World of Jesus. Using the Sunday readings from Cycle C, which we will start using beginning in Advent, this book presents several short essays about cultural reflections on the Gospel. Each essay highlights aspects of the first century, Eastern Mediterranean, cultural world in which Jesus lived and suggests a cross-cultural comparison with contemporary western culture.

The Joy of the Gospel is Pope Francis' first encyclical which is a call to begin a new chapter in evangelization.

Laudato Si, On Care for Our Common Home. We are united by our concern for the well being of our planets and every living thing that dwells on it, especially the poorest and most vulnerable. Francis combines Catholic social teaching with the best scientific research.

The Joy of Love by Pope Francis was written after the synod. Francis invites us to see the joy of love in families, aware of the complications and messiness of family life. It's a must read for every family.

On Fraternity and Social Friendship is Pope Francis' "cry from the heart" to all people of the earth to see beyond their differences and to begin to grow together to create a new and peaceful world.

Let Us Dream is a reflection on the Covid crisis and how we can't go back to the way things were. Covid exposed the plight of the world's poor during and after Covid. He offers a brilliant, scathing critique of the systems and ideologies that have conspired to produce the current crisis – from a global economy obsessed with profit and heedless of the people and the environment it harms to politicians who foment their people's fear and use that to increase their own power at the people's expense.

On Heaven and Earth is about dialogues between Pope Francis (before he became pope) and Rabbi Abraham Skorka. Originally published in 2010, these two men compare notes on a wide variety of topics. A pope and a rabbi walk into a bar?

The final book is by Fr. James Martin, S.J. titled **Building a Bridge**, how the Catholic Church and the LGBTQ community enter into a relationship of respect, compassion, and sensitivity.
