


OUR MISSION STATEMENT



Baptism Living in Relationship

How fitting that we are celebrating the Baptism of the Lord today, not John's baptism of repentance, but God's gift of love, freely, undeservedly, given to us, through Jesus. On the banks of the Jordan River, while Jesus prayed, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended on Him. A voice came from heaven. "You are my beloved Son; with You I am well pleased." Present was God the Father in the Voice, God the Spirit descending from Heaven, and God the Son, Jesus, on earth, one like us. Trinity. Present at our baptism through the words of the priest, "I baptize you, in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit." Trinity.

Going under the baptismal water signifies a death to our former self and rising from the water as a new Child of God, filled with the new life and light of the risen Christ. We are called to live in relationship with God as our Father, and as brother and sister with Christ and all God's people. Baptism, with the gift of Trinity, fills us with Divine life. God above me. God around me. God within me.

We are God's presence for another. Luke tells us that a voice came from heaven and said, "You are my beloved Son." As we receive Eucharist, we hear a voice say, "The Body of Christ." This is who we receive. This is who we are. The Body of Christ.

We encounter God in others and all of creation. God dwells in the Spirit in everything that God has created. Opening our hearts to this love, the Spirit can help us not to miss these encounters and to use them to know God, know who we are, and know who we are called to be. As we conform our hearts to God's will, to Jesus' way of loving, we hear the whisper, "With you I am well pleased."

Liturgically, we leave Christmas behind but filled with joy from the Incarnation's Good News. God loves us, desires to be in union with us, just as we were created, just as we are. Because God is good so are we!

The gifts of baptism will reinforce our being as we move into Ordinary Time. As we planned our Blessed Trinity Parish 2024 picture directory, we knew what the cover had to be as soon as we saw this picture. Gary Williams, coming up from the waters of baptism. Pure joy! Not the best quality photo, to be sure, but it captures exactly who we are here, at Blessed Trinity. We know what Christian community and discipleship mean. We live it. We begin Ordinary Time claiming the strengths and gifts of our baptism.

So, I return to my opening statement. How fitting that as we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, and bring this Christmas season to a close, I leave behind my years of Diocesan ministry and enter retirement. (notice I re-worded "move into retirement" I'm not moving, just going home to clean my house!) I don't even have the words to describe these 34 years (10 years teaching in Ascension School, 10 years on Core Team at Ascension Church, 14 years on staff at Blessed Trinity). I feel like Gary! My heart is full, so much gratitude. Doug's suggestion for a note from you is perfect. You are my community. You mean so much to me. I look forward to being parishioner, Katie. May grace give me strength as I find my new direction.
