



FROM THE DESK OF FR DOUG...

A Flourishing, Apostolic Church A Pastoral Letter from Bishop Edward Malesic

All of you received the recent pastoral letter from Bishop Malesic titled, A Flourishing Apostolic Church. The letter focuses on worship, evangelization and service. It contains four sections 1. The Paschal Mystery 2. Friendship with God 3. Becoming missionary disciples and 4. The Apostolic parish.

I'd like to focus attention on part three, iii, where he talks about Communal Encounters with God: Faith Sharing, Small Groups and Retreat experiences. The bishop writes:

In our diocese, the people who are most involved in the life of the church, the life of the diocese, and the life of their parish are often people who are also a part of a small group within the parish where they are regularly seen, known and loved. We all need a small circle of friends with whom we can share our faith, to grow in our faith. I am encouraging each Catholic to become a part of some small faith sharing group, whether it is formal or informal, a bible study, or a book club..." (Emphasis mine.)

In our parish we have many opportunities for just such a vision of faith sharing. We have several faith-sharing groups, some of which have been around for decades. We have new prayer groups which formed after our Ignatian spirituality retreats, We have the Ragamuffin women's group, We have the Centering Prayer Group., We have bible study. We have LGBTQ+ faith sharing group. We just finished our first shared book experience, reading and reflecting on the book, Living the Mass.

That list of activities looks impressive, and it is. But when I look closer and add up the number of participants, I see that the number of parishioners who are actually involved in some kind of faith sharing or small group is small.

I have been asking myself how to engage more people in the parish in the kind of small group sharing that the bishop encourages. Is there some fear of sharing one's faith journey with strangers and if so how can we alleviate that fear? Is someone just waiting to be asked to join a faith sharing group? Do people not see the value of a small group as the bishop described it. Do people need a ride? Is babysitting needed? Are people just content to do the minimum? I have tons of questions about how to get more people involved. Do people think "I'm not good enough, or holy enough to be in a prayer group? Do people think "I have nothing to offer?"

I think I will start by simply inviting you to sign up to be part of a faith-sharing group. Then we will have an organizational meeting, perhaps to group people with similar interests such as families with small children, or widows and widowers, and so on. On the other hand, some groups prefer diversity to get a different perspective on our faith.

What happens at a faith sharing group? Most of our prayer groups use the following format though it is not mandatory: begin with fifteen minutes of socializing, then an opening prayer from a book or a saint or Richard Rohr or some such person, then reading the upcoming Sunday Gospel (or all three readings) followed by sharing on the question, "what spoke to me in the readings today?" Or as St. Ignatius taught in *lectio divina*, 'what one word grabbed my attention?'

Perhaps a prayer group will discern the call to service out of state that Briyant mentioned in his bulletin article last week.


