



Lenten Opportunities

Please bring your dried palms to church by Monday morning, March 3 so that they can be burned for the distribution of Ashes on Ash Wednesday

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5. The traditional Lenten practices associated with this penitential season, prayer, fasting and almsgiving are found in Matthew 6:1-18. Our parish is providing the following opportunities for you

Prayer

There will be a Mass on Ash Wednesday at 12:05pm with the distribution of ashes. There will be a Liturgy of the Word service in the evening at 7:30pm. Abbey Meyer will be the guest homilist. Come support her and get a feminine perspective on the season of Lent.

There will be a sign-up sheet at the back table for those who would like to be a part of a prayer group. This will be just during the season of Lent. Afterwards the group or groups will decide if they would like to continue.

You might want to take advantage of Breaking Open the Word which is every Sunday between Masses in the rectory. Laura Fibbi leads these discussions about the readings.

There will be prayer cards available in the pews with pictures of those children and adults who will be celebrating their sacraments of initiation in the Easter season,. You are encouraged to take one or more prayer cards home during the Lenten season to pray for these candidates for the sacraments.

Fasting

Lent is a time for sacrifice and fasting. The word sacrifice comes from two Latin words meaning "to make holy". If you choose some sacrificial practice, like giving up chocolate, make sure it is making you holier.

On Ash Wednesday at 6:00pm we will have our annual simple soup supper. You are invited to bring a meatless soup to share with others. This simple meal may leave us a little hungry, reminding us to hunger for the Lord. Bring your recipes too. People like to exchange them. The parish will provide bread and beverages.

Once again we are promoting Dump Your Plump. Are you looking to take advantage of the season of Lent by dieting and working on your wellness. Why do that alone? It's easier with a partner. There will be a sign-up sheet for those who would like to participate in dump your plump. This will simply be a chance to check in with a buddy every day to check on and encourage your

diet plan, and to recommit yourself to it is you suffer a setback.

Almsgiving

Our parish will be encouraging contributions to Water For Life, a program by Cross Catholic to drill community wells — giving families clean and abundant water for life in the sub-Saharan countries of Ghana, Malawi. Ethiopia. Kenya, Eswatini and Zambia.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday and every weekend Mass, a plastic tub will be brought forward at the offertory. You will then be invited to come forward and donate to Water for Life in the same way that we bring our baby bottles forward for Womankind. You can come up every week and drop a dollar in the tub or just come once and put in some change. We will be able to move the tub to fish fries to give others the opportunity to give alms to the thirsty of the world.

Miscellaneous

On Fridays during Lent we will be having fish fries from 5:30-7:30pm in Fogarty Hall. This is not so much a fund-raiser as it is a community builder. People often come at 5:30 and stay until 7:30 just to visit and chat — well and to enjoy many of the delicious homemade desserts. This is why we also have Dump Your Plump during Lent.

The Chosen, Season Five, is previewing at the theatre beginning March 26, April 4th and April 11th. I'll get more details in case we want to attend as a group like last time.

Vegetable, herb and flower seeds will be available for free next weekend. Many thanks to Puritas Nursery who have given us over \$1,000 worth of seeds. The first week of March is the time to plant them indoors in peat pods or other containers with topsoil.
