



As President Trump seeks to purge the federal government of "woke" initiatives, agencies have flagged hundreds of words to limit or avoid, according to a compilation of government documents. The purge follows Secretary of Defense Pete Hegseth's directive last week for the Pentagon to "remove all DoD news and feature articles, photos, and videos that promote Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)," citing Trump's executive order. They are:

One hilarious outcome from the complete list was references to the Enola Gay aircraft that dropped an atomic bomb on Japan during World War II have been flagged for removal in Pentagon documents as the Department of Defense purges references related to diversity, equity and inclusion—in this case, presumably because of the word "gay."
