


OUR MISSION STATEMENT

FROM THE DESK OF FR DOUG...

The Beauty of Holy Week is Upon Us

Holy Week begins with the vigil Mass on Saturday. It is the most solemn week of the year. During this week we commemorate the saving love of Jesus Christ who is the perfect model of Christian love. The liturgies of Holy Week speak for themselves and are filled with symbolism, rituals, and prayers. Homilies are to be short or omitted altogether. If done well, the Holy Week liturgies move, inspire and challenge us..

On Palm Sunday, we will gather outside, weather permitting, for the blessing of palms. Then we will process into church singing 'Sing "Hosanna" to the Chosen One.' And yet, we are not re-enacting that first Palm Sunday. We are entering into it ritually that we might be touched and formed by it.

The Liturgy of the Word includes the reading of the Passion according to St. Luke. It is long, maybe 15 minutes. As always I encourage you to stand through it like we always do for the proclamation of the Gospel, but if you can't, please feel free to be seated.

The Palm Sunday liturgy ends in silence. Please respect that silence. It only takes one person to ruin that solemn ending. We leave church quietly to digest the meaning of this solemn feast. Talking may resume after the procession is over. Letter writing about immigration policy will then begin.

On Tuesday of Holy Week, Bishop Malesic will celebrate the Chrism Mass at 7:00pm at the cathedral. The entire diocese is invited to join him for this special liturgy. At this Mass, the oils used for the sacraments of initiation will be blessed along with the oil of the sick.

On Holy Thursday we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. In this liturgy we read of the washing of the feet from John's Gospel. John emphasizes that the Eucharistic meal is a call to service. All are invited to come forward and have their feet washed.

After the petitions, the oils blessed by the bishop, are brought up is procession before the Preparation of the Gifts.

At the end of the Holy Thursday liturgy the entire congregation will process to the altar of repose. There we will stand and pray for a moment, then disperse in silence. You are invited to "stay awake with Jesus" before the Blessed Sacrament any time between the time the Mass ends and 11:00pm.

Our Good Friday Service this year begins at noon. It has three parts: the liturgy of the word, the veneration of the cross and communion. Come and join us for this commemoration of the anniversary of the death of our Savior, Jesus the Christ.

The Easter vigil is the most glorious liturgy of the year. It has four parts. The first is the celebration of light in which we bless the primal fires outside and then process into church for the hymn, the Exultet.

Part two is the liturgy of the word in which we hear the highlights of salvation history from seven readings of the Old Testament. After the epistle reading, we finally sing the word "Alleluia" once again, signifying the joy of the risen Christ.

Part three is the liturgy of baptism. During this part of the liturgy, those preparing for reception into the church will receive their sacraments. Clare Moriarity Gainley will receive the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation and later in the Mass, first Eucharist. Morgan Gimlett Gainley will be baptized during this part of the Mass.

Part four is the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Energized and uplifted by the previous parts of the vigil., we come to the table of the Lord to receive the Risen Christ in the Eucharist. It is the body of Risen Christ that we receive, not the body of Jesus.

I want to thank in advance Julio Santana our music minister, who has worked so hard to make out music uplifting and prayerful, the adult choir, the bell choir, the lectors who memorized their readings, Steve and Anne Suding who served as sacristans throughout Holy Week and did so much behind the scenes work, and all those involved in any liturgical ministry. Our parish is blessed because of you.
